From the indoor Las Vegas Ice Center to the outdoor rink in the Roman Plaza at Caesars Palace, the city has half a dozen ice skating venues. SoBe Ice Arena at Fiesta Rancho casino throws adult skate parties every Friday and Saturday night, with holiday themes in the run-up

ski school and shops.

Las Vegas also serves as a convenient base for snow sport safaris to family-friendly Brian Head in southwest Utah. In addition to four terrain parks for snowboarding, the resort offers sleigh rides, snowshoeing and a unique Snow Tubing Park with frozen versions of water slides. Three hours up Interstate 15, the trek can be done as a single (long) daytrip from Vegas.



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
