## Snapshot: Brian Head, Utah

The Grand Lodge is exactly what Brian Head, Utah, needed: stylish, high-end, impeccably decorated with rock and wood, 100 luxurious guestrooms and suites, a steakhouse that rivals any big-city Zagat winners, a stunning loft bar with a sit-around indoor fireplace, and a full-service spa that would be right at home in Palm Springs. It's the final touch that now makes Brian Head every bit as enticing as Tahoe.

At 9,600 feet above sea level, Brian Head Resort offers more than 650 acres of skiable terrain, and with nearly 400 inches of annual snowfall, there's always plenty of fresh powder on the ground. Yet the crowds are a fraction of those who descend on Mammoth. All-day lift tickets, good at the entire resort, are just \$45 for adults and \$32 for children.
